## General Rules

- 1) All entries must be submitted no later than October 1, 2020 at 5:00pm. Entries can be mailed or emailed to the addresses listed above.
- 2) Under Tennessee State law, each horse shall provide show office with current copy of Negative Coggins. Any horse traveling from out of state must also present a Certificate of Health dated within 30 days of the show.
- 3) Spectators are welcome if all Covid-19 protocols are followed. It is recommended that spectators bring their own chairs to sit on the grass berm around the ring. Please remember to social distance when sitting in groups of people.
- 4) All Dogs must be on a leash when on the show grounds
- 5) A fee of \$50.00 will be charged for all returned checks

## Liability Waivers

**\*By signing the entry blank, all riders, owners, trainers, and spectators are agreeing to the following rules and releases\***

1) Signors give Harlinsdale Show Series its owners, employees, and associates, their authorization to initiate emergency first aid and medical treatment for their children, animals, and themselves in case of an accident or injury. Signors understand they are solely responsible for any expense associated with emergency medical, veterinary or farrier treatment.

2) Signors acknowledge the Covid-19 Protocols and agree to follow them to their strictest interpretation.

By signing the entry blank, I RELEASE, WAIVE, DISCHARGE AND COVENANT NOT TO SUE HARLINSDALE SHOW SERIES, WHIRLWIND FARM and/ or AMY RIPPEL, their operators, horse owners, investors, and each of them, their officers, agents, employees, lessees, and participants (all hereafter collectively referred to as RELEASEES) from any and all claims, loss, damage and liability to the UNDERSIGNED, his or her personal representatives, assigns, heirs, next of kin, or anyone claiming through them, arising out of any liability or negligence of RELEASEES which causes the UNDERSIGNED injury, death, damages or property damages. I HEREBY COVENANT to hold RELEASEES harmless and indemnify RELEASEES for any claim, judgment or expense, including attorney's fees and costs of litigation RELEASEES may incur arising out of my activities or presence, or travel to or from, at or on the farm or on the property of RELEASEES or at horse shows or other horse related events.

2. I UNDERSTAND that my entry onto the farm or premises of RELEASEES, riding, showing or attending horse shows involves DANGER AND RISK OF INJURY OR DEATH, that conditions of horseback riding and horses change from time to time and may become more HAZARDOUS, and that there is INHERENT DANGER in horses and riding which I appreciate and VOLUNTARILY ASSUME because I CHOOSE TO DO SO. I have observed horses and riding of the type that I seek to participate in and have inspected the grounds, horse and equipment provided. I further know that other riders, horses and participants pose a danger to me, nevertheless, I VOLUNTARILY ELECT TO ACCEPT ALL RISKS connected therewith and/or my participation.

### WARNING

**Under Tennessee Law, an equine professional is not liable for an injury to or death of a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities, pursuant to Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 44, Chapter 20, Section 1.**

## **Show Rules**

- 1) ASTM/SEI approved helmets must be worn at all times while mounted on the show grounds
- 2) Unless otherwise stated, 3 entries are required to run a class. All 3 entries must enter and COMPLETE the course or undersaddle. Show Management reserves the right to cancel any class if entry number minimums have not been met, or to combine classes under MTHJA rules. Divisions with less than 6 competitors in each section – Child/Adult, Junior/Amateur, and all pony heights – will remain combined.
- 3) The Harlinsdale Show Series are operated in accordance with the current rules of the MTHJA.
- 4) All horses on the grounds must be entered, or registered as a Non-Showing horse. Back numbers will be required to school on Friday.

## **Covid-19 Rules**

- 1) Current local and state Covid-19 guidelines will take precedence over any previously published protocols.
- 2) You may not enter the competition grounds if you:
  - a. Exhibit COVID-19 symptoms (potential symptoms: Fever or chills, Cough, Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, Fatigue, Muscle or body aches, Headache, New loss of taste or smell, Sore throat, Congestion or runny nose, Nausea or vomiting, Diarrhea)
  - b. Have tested positive for COVID-19 within last two weeks
  - c. Have been in contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 within the last two weeks
- 3) Any individual who was present on the competition grounds and tests positive for COVID-19 within 14 days of the conclusion of the competition, must immediately notify the Show Manager
- 4) All staff, officials, volunteers, service providers and participants (includes trainers, grooms, riders, minor rider legal guardians and horse owners) must wear face mask covering both nose and mouth at all times while on competition grounds in any setting where there is a possibility of being within six feet of any other individual, and when not mounted on a horse.
- 5) Individuals must socially distance (or physically distance) on the competition grounds by staying at least 6 feet (about 2 arms' length) from any person who is not a member of their immediate household.
- 6) Wash hands or sanitize hands frequently
- 7) Any individual not complying with all Covid-19 rules will be required to leave the competition grounds.

## HUNTER CLASSES

Division	Classes	Height	Specifications
Walk / Trot	51, 52, 53, 54*	18" crossrails	4-8 jumps. Cantering will be penalized. May only cross-enter into Green Rider. Will be judged on the rider.
Green Rider	55, 56, 57, 58*	2' crossrails	4-8 jumps. Trotting or Cantering allowed. May cross-enter into Walk/Trot if eligible. Will be judged on the rider.
Beginner Rider	2, 3, 4*	2'	Course with at least 1 change of direction. Trotting not penalized. Open to any rider that hasn't competed at 2'. May cross-enter into Green Rider if eligible.
Short Stirrup Hunter	5, 6, 7*	2'	Open to riders 12 years old or younger that have never shown over 2'6". Rider may not cross-enter into any class with fence heights over 2'.
Long Stirrup Hunter	5, 6, 7*	2'	Open to riders 13 years old and older that have never shown over 2'6". May not cross-enter into any class with fence height over 2'3"
Pre Child/Adult Hunter	27, 28, 29*	2'3"-2'6"	Open to horses or ponies ridden by junior or amateur exhibitors. Rider may not cross-enter into any class with fence heights 3' or higher.
Children's Pony Hunter	12, 13, 14*	2' (S/M), 2'6" (L)	Open to ponies ridden by a junior exhibitor per Zone 4 specifications. To be judged on performance, soundness, manners, way of going.
Pony Hunter	18, 19, 20*	2', 2'6", 2'9"	Open to horses or ponies ridden by junior exhibitors
Modified Junior Hunter	30, 31, 32*	2'6"-2'9"	Open to horses or ponies ridden by junior or amateur exhibitors
Children's Hunter	43, 44, 45*	3'	Open to horses and ponies ridden by a junior exhibitor.
Adult Hunter	43, 44, 45*	3'	Open to riders who are no longer eligible to complete as a junior exhibitor.
Junior/Amateur Hunter	46, 47, 48*	3'3"	Open to all junior and amateur riders
Special Hunter	10, 11, 24, 25, 26*, 40, 41	2', 2'6", 3"	Open to all horses, ponies and riders. Only 1 U/S will be run, and all heights will be combined, unless 6 entries compete @ each height
Warm Up Hunter	1, 50	division height	Open with each division height
