No one will be allowed to school until a number is issued from the show office.

**Rules and Regulations:**

1. Under Tennessee State law, each horse shall provide the show office with current copy of negative coggins (less than 12 months from date drawn). Additionally, all horses coming from outside Tennessee must comply with Tennessee laws prior to arriving on the show grounds and have a health certificate when applicable.
2. Proper riding attire is required at all times. All riders must wear ASTM-SEI approved helmets with harness fastened.
3. Martingales are not permitted in under saddle classes, equitation flat classes or the flat phase of the Medal classes.

4. Unconventional hunter tack or equipment will only be permitted at the judge's discretion.
5. The Silent Run Show Series is operated in accordance with the current rules of the MTHJA. To be eligible for year end awards, the exhibitor, the owner and the horse or pony must be registered with the Association. Applications are available from the show secretary.
6. Silent Run Farm Show Series Year – End Ribbons and High Point Awards for Rider/Horse Combinations in each division that shows in a minimum of 3 Silent Run Shows during 2021.
